


Mason of the Month

Frederick A. Stanley (1841-1908)

Stanley was a British politician and sportsman, who was in 1888 appointed Governor General of Canada. Stanley's sons were avid hockey players. In 1892, he donated a cup to be used as a challenge cup between amateur teams. In 1902, the cup was designated for professional teams. In 1926, the cup was the trophy for the NHL. The original cup was 7 inches high, and the current cup is more than 36 inches. Stanley's term of Governor General of Canada ended in 1893, and he returned to England and became Lord Mayor of Liverpool.

Stanley was a member of Royal Alpha Lodge #16, London, England.
