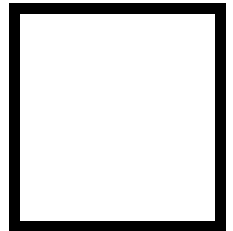

Greetings Brothers,

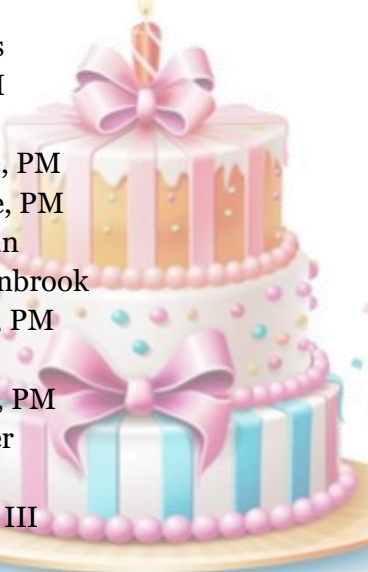

Mason of the Month

Charles Bathurst—1st Viscount Bledisloe (1867-1958)

London born, Eton and Oxford educated, Bathurst was a member of Parliament and a Privy Councillor to King George V. As Lord Bledisloe, he was appointed Governor General of New Zealand.

As a fan of rugby, he conceived the idea of a trophy between Australia and New Zealand called the Bledisloe Cup.

He was a dedicated Freemason and served as Grand Master of the New Zealand Constitution (1930-1933).
