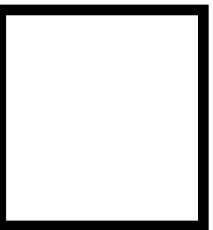

Mason of the Month

John C Ainsworth (1822-1893)

A native of Ohio, Ainsworth traveled to California for the gold rush. It was a dud for him.

He then traveled north to Oregon and founded the Oregon Steam Navigation Company, that ran steamships on the Willamette River. He was Grand Master of Oregon Masons.

He founded The Valley of Portland Scottish Rite, and was Sovereign Grand Inspector General of the Orient of Oregon. At one time, this writer lived two blocks from Ainsworth St. in North Portland.
