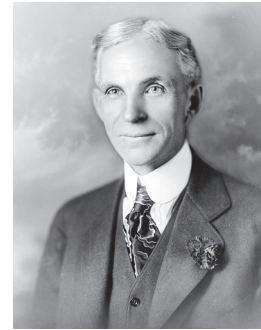
Mason of the Month

Henry Ford (1863-1947)

Ford was the founder of the Ford Motor Company. In the 1880's he was repairing and building gas engines, and by the 1890's was working for Edison Electric. In 1908 his Ford Motor Co introduced the Model T for \$825 (\$27,980 today). In 1913, he introduced the moving assembly belt resulting in drop in price to \$360 by 1916.

In 1914, Ford offered a daily wage of \$5 (\$152 today) along with a five day work week. He promoted a franchise system allowing for dealerships. In 1926, he introduced the Ford Tri motor airplane, and in WWII was building the B-24 bomber. With failing health, Ford ceded the company presidency to Henry Ford II in 1945. Ford was raised in Palestine Lodge #357, Detroit, MI, and was a 33 deg Scottish Rite. Ford once said "Masonry is the best balance wheel in the United States."

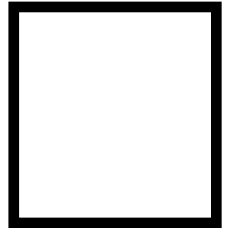
