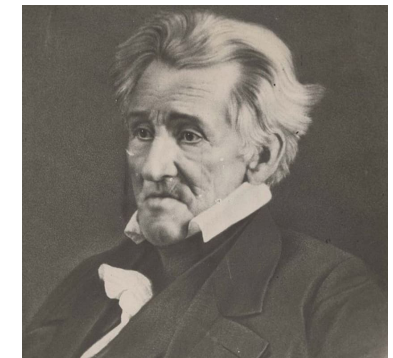


Mason of the Month

Andrew Jackson (1767-1845) 7th President of the United States Jackson was a lawyer, army general, a politician who served in both houses of Congress, a Justice on Tennessee's Supreme Court, and President. He was a wealthy plantation and slave owner, and was criticized in his presidency for the "Ethnic Cleansing" of the Indian Act. He was the Commander of the Tennessee Militia and won several battles, notably The Battle of New Orleans.

Jackson was Grand Master of Mason for Tennessee in 1822-1823.
